Joint Spatial Plan for the Greater Carlow Graiguecullen Urban Area 2013-2019

Pursuant to Section 11 of the Planning and Development Acts 2000 as amended, Carlow Town Council, being the Planning Authority for the functional area known as Carlow Town, hereby gives notice of its intention to review its existing Town Development Plan 2009-2015 and prepare a new Town Development Plan for its area for the period 2013-2019.

It is the intention of Carlow County Council, Carlow Town Council and Laois County Council to prepare a Joint Spatial Plan for the Greater Carlow Graiguecullen Urban Area 2013-2019. The Joint Spatial Plan will constitute the Carlow Town Development Plan together with the Local Area Plans for Graiguecullen and Carlow Town Environs under the Planning and Development Act 2000-2010.

The Joint Spatial Plan will set out a strategic framework for the proper planning and sustainable development of the Greater Carlow Graiguecullen Urban Area over a six-year period. It will include sets of development objectives, development policies, development standards and zoning maps.

An Issues Paper has been prepared which relates to Carlow Town, Graiguecullen and Carlow Town Environs. The Issues Paper is available for inspection at Carlow County Library, Carlow County Buildings, Graiguecullen Area Office, Carlow Town Hall and at Aras an Chontae, Portlaoise during usual public opening hours and on www.carlow.ie and on www.laois.ie

Submissions or observations regarding the objectives and policies to deliver an overall strategy for the proper planning and sustainable development of Carlow Town maybe made in writing from 29th March, 2011 to 4.00 p.m. on 24th May, 2011. Children or groups or associations representing the interests of children are also entitled to make submissions or observations. Carlow Town Council intends to review the zoning of the area of its development plan to deliver an overall strategy for the proper planning and sustainable development of the area and to prepare a core strategy.

Submissions or observations relating to Graiguecullen and Carlow Town Environs elements of the proposed Joint Spatial Plan maybe made in writing from 29th March, 2011 to 4.00 p.m. on 24th May, 2011.

Any group or organisation wishing to arrange a meeting to discuss the Joint Spatial Plan may contact Council staff at the above email address before 24th May, 2011.

The Planning Authorities propose to carry out a Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA), including an environmental report of the likely significant effects on the environment of implementing the Joint Spatial Plan, and the provisions of articles 13C to 13J and 14C to 14J of SEA Regulations (SI No. 436 of 2004) will apply. Pursuant to Articles 6(3) and 6(4) of the Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC) the Planning Authorities will prepare an Appropriate Assessment relating to likely effects of implementing the Joint Spatial Plan on the conservation objectives of relevant Natura 2000 sites.
